This class is a tithing class; a tithe will be taken for Unity at the completion of each class.

- A. **Course Description:** This transformational course is an experiential and interactive class that puts into practice the laws of abundance and secrets of prosperity. What this class requires is that students take to task their own limiting beliefs, so that they can begin to shift their lives and awaken their divine potential. Each evening Syntysche will speak on prosperity topics such as “Accessing the Invisible Ether”, “The Healing Power of Joy”, “Turning Failure into Success” and “Making your Master Demonstration.” Syntysche will speak on the topic of the night for 45 minutes at the beginning of each class. Following the talk, students will be guided in meditation. Syntysche will be introducing different meditation and prayer techniques so that students may discover for themselves which practices best help them to access Spirit, Source, or God within. Then, the students will divide into small groups (3 to 4 people) to answer questions and share insights they have about the topic of the evening. The last half hour, the class will come back into one large group to do an exercise with Syntysche. For homework, the students will practice applying the techniques and practices learned in class that week.
- B. **Instructor Description:** Syntysche Groverland, Associate Minister of Unity of Boulder Spiritual Center, Syntysche has been teaching Unity classes, including Prosperity classes for over 16 years. She has also completed Unity’s Spiritual Education and Enrichment Program and is a Licensed Unity Leader. Syntysche is a natural at helping students feel comfortable so that they may share what is not working in their lives and begin to shift it. Her belief in the divine potential of each of her students is truly empowering. Students learn to create different and better results in their lives by accessing their power within. Syntysche has a soft place in her heart for teaching spiritual classes. She is right at home

in her experiential classrooms. She has been perfecting her classes for many years to best impress the tools & techniques for an applicable outcome for her students. Syntysche grew up in the Unity Church, so she has a deep knowledge and understanding of the spiritual journey and she knows how to encourage and inspire the students to awaken to a beautiful and new reality.
